1.4 CERS/CEC Sports Rules

Rules

The CEC Official Regulations (Sports Rules) - 2015 edition with the latest amendments - and CERS Rules will be valid for these Championships.

1.5 Participation Conditions

Affiliation

The participation is allowed only to countries affiliated to CERS and updated with their CERS fees.

SENIOR European Championship

- A total of eight male and eight female skaters may be registered in the Championship for each attending country.
- No more than three (3) male and three (3) female skaters can participate in each distance/calendar events.

JUNIOR A European Championship

- A total of eight male and eight female skaters may be registered in the Championship for each attending country.
- No more than three (3) male and three (3) female skaters can participate in each distance/calendar events.

JUNIOR B European Championship

- A total of eight male and eight female skaters may be registered in the Championship for each attending country.
- No more than three (3) male and three (3) female skaters can participate in each distance/calendar events.

Age Skaters allowed to participate at the European Championships must have the following age:

SENIOR Category

- 20 years old (born in 1995 – whole year) and older

JUNIOR A Category

- 18 years old (born in 1997 – whole year)
- 19 years old (born in 1996 – whole year)

Age **JUNIOR B Category**

- 16 years old (born in 1999 – whole year)
- 17 years old (born in 1998 – whole year)

CADETS

High start for the oldest Cadets in the Junior B Category

- 15 years old (born in 2000 – whole year)

1.6 Checks

Anti-Doping **Anti-Doping Control**

Anti-doping controls will be carried out according to CERS/FIRS Medical Regulations and WADA Rules.

Sex Check **Check of Female Sex**

No female sex certificate is required. Nevertheless, in conformity with IOC guidelines, CERS/CEC is entitled to conduct tests on specific occasions.

This would mean laboratory tests could be done if there is a suspicion.

1.7 Examination Sessions for Judges

Test for Judges

No test/examination session for European judges in 2015.

The CEC together with CIC started a project to promote/examine continental judges. Dates of examination will be published soon

→ an examination is planned during the European Cup stage in Oostende and it is yet confirmed by the CIC.

1.8 Visa Requirements

Visa

Should you need assistance to obtain an Austrian entry visa or require a specific letter of invitation, please contact the CEC as soon as possible.

2. Operational Part

2.1 Preparation of the Championships

2.1.1 Financial Conditions and Payment of Fees

Entry Fees

Each participating country will pay the following entry fees:

- EUR 0, -- no fee for each country participating at the Senior/Junior A/Junior B Championship
- EUR 60,-- for each senior, junior A, junior B and cadet skater entered for the Track Championship
- EUR 60,-- for each senior, junior A, junior B and cadet skater entered for the Road Championship
- EUR 10,-- for each additional skater in the marathon (maximum 2 per country and category)

Paying Conditions

Fees must be paid (**without additional bank expenses** for CEC) until **July 1, 2015**.

The fees will be summed up in an invoice which will be sent to the federations after the arrival of the **registration form by country** (see 2.1.2).

Expenses

Each participating team will pay its own travelling, board and lodging expenses.

2.1.2.3 Check (Passports and Entry Fees)

Passport/ payment check

Scheduled on Saturday July 18, 2015 between **15.00 and 17.00 hrs** at the track in Wörgl.

Delegates of all attending countries are kindly requested to be present in order to confirm their entry and nationality of the skaters:

- Presentation of the passports of all attending athletes
- **Registration forms per race and category** have to be handed in filled out at least with the attending skaters of the first race day
(document: *Euro-Champs-2015_Tirol_Reg-Form_per-race_... .xls*);
- **No payments in cash accepted** at registration (see 2.1);
- Delegates must submit a corresponding proof/photocopy of the payment (e-banking).

2.1.2.4 Transponders

Transponders

We will use transponders which will be handed out together with the start numbers at the registration or at the venue to the delegates.

A deposit will be charged for the transponders.

2.1.3 Accommodation and Meals

Payments

All payments for accommodations must be paid by the federations. Payment can be made only directly to the tourist office by cash, Mastercard, Visa or in advance by bank transfer.

Hotel requirements must be communicated directly to the tourist office through the attached forms. We have contingents in different hotels in the area.

On race day vouchers for meals can be bought at the competition site until 10 am.

Meals at the hotel need to be arranged directly at the hotel.

2.1.4 Parking for Mobile Homes

Mobile Homes

SC Lattella Wörgl can also offer a little number of arrangement for mobile homes near the Speedskatearena. Parking places for mobile homes have to be booked in advance through the organizer.

No tents and caravans are allowed!

2.2 Media Accreditation

2.3.1 Liability/Responsibility

Liability The Comité Européen de Course and the organiser **are not responsible** for any accident that may occur during travel, before, during or after the event/championships.

The SC Lattella Wörgl club assume no responsibility or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property damage incurred in connection with the CERS/CEC European Championships Inline Speed Skating. Each Member is solely responsible for providing insurance coverage thereto. It is the sole responsibility of each federation participating in the event to provide medical insurance for their skaters and staff.
